On Saturday, September 11, 2010 the HERO 101 FUND will hold the 5th Annual Jeremy Chambers Memorial Golf Tournament. The tournament is held annually in honor of Patrolman Jeremy Chambers who lost his life on April 24, 2006 when he was struck head on by a drunk driver while serving the citizens of the Village of Cahokia. Jeremy was the first Cahokia Police Officer to be killed in the line of duty.

As in years past, proceeds from the tournament will be placed into the HERO 101 FUND which was started in Jeremy's honor. The Fund has made donations to Police Officers and Firefighters in the St. Louis Metropolitan Area. Donations have been made to or in the name of Police Officers from Cahokia, Centreville, Lebanon, Belleville, Kirkwood, St. Louis City, University City and St. Louis County, as well as, Firefighters from St. Louis City, Maplewood and the Prairie Du Pont Fire Departments. The HERO 101 Fund also made donations to MADD, ILCOPS and Backstopper's Inc.

This year's tournament is especially meaningful as it is being held on September 11th. As a member of the Cahokia Volunteer Fire Department, Jeremy, along with several others, went to New York to assist in the aftermath of the World Trade Center attacks. This was typical of Jeremy, giving of himself to assist others. We are asking you to help make this day a very special and successful day in honor of Jeremy and all of those that lost their lives on September 11, 2001.
